In Joel 1:14, the Lord directs Joel to proclaim a fast and call for the leaders and people to gather in the house of the Lord to pray to the Lord. The situation Israel found itself in was one of dire need, with the land and the people drifting away from God. But if the people gathered to pray and to fast, the Lord will be jealous for His land and have pity and answer His people. (2:18-19)

God is calling us to do the same. Our people, churches, and nations face many trials, temptations, and a lack of concern for God's leadership. It is time to gather to pray and fast. We will not pray only ourselves, but will also use this time to effect change throughout our nation by praying, fasting, and seeking God. Sunday, May 17, each local CH Church is requested to hold a prayer time from 6 to 7 pm. Our purpose in coming together is to follow God's guidance and pray for our nation, our Christian community, and one another, trusting that God will fulfill His intentions through this period of prayer and fasting.

One Another

This year's prayer focus is ONE ANOTHER, guided by relevant scriptures throughout the WKND of Prayer and Fasting. While additional prayer points are provided, the Holy Spirit ultimately leads our prayers. I encourage everyone to remain attentive to the Spirit during prayer. As we pray, God acts and brings order—let us pray for ONE ANOTHER.

By praying and fasting for unity, we believe God will bring spiritual renewal to the Church, our nation, and the world.

One Another

When we pray together God moves supernaturally. Matthew 18:19 instructs us that if as few as two of us agree (pray) on anything here on earth, our Father in heaven will do it. As we use this prayer focuses let us agree together during our prayer times and allow the Holy Spirit to direct our prayers and see how God will respond in His majesty and glory. I am thankful we can pray together. ***We are Better Together!***

- **ONE ANOTHER:** Pray for those we are supposed to love our brothers, the lost, our enemies.

John 13:34-35 - *A new commandment I give unto you, **That ye love one another;** as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if **ye have love one to another.***

- **ONE ANOTHER:** Pray we have a heart to serve as Christ served.

Galatians 5:13 - *For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but **by love serve one another.***

- **ONE ANOTHER:** Unity in the Church, Nation, and Israel.

Romans 12:16 - *Be of the **same mind one toward another.** Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.*

- **ONE ANOTHER:** Pray for those in need at home and abroad. Humility in the Church.

Galatians 6:2 - ***Bear ye one another's burdens** and so fulfil the law of Christ. To be guided by His skillful hands.*

- **ONE ANOTHER:** Pray for the Church Universal.

Hebrews 10:24-25 - *And let us **consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:** Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.*

- **ONE ANOTHER:** Prayer for forgiveness and repentance. As an Individual, Church, Nation.

Colossians 3:13 - ***Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another,** if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye.*
